

Off Campus Lunch Policy

The setting of Meridian School and its location within the community supports our need for a closed campus; however, we desire to offer the privilege of off campus lunch to students that are in *good standing at Meridian School. School policy states that students are not allowed to leave campus during the school day without **prior written permission** from the parent/guardian and approval from the administration. If the following rules are maintained, juniors and seniors that are in good standing may have permission to leave campus for lunch.

By signing below, you agree to the following:

1. I will not visit other school campuses during lunch.
2. I will not transport or ride with other students who do not have off campus privileges.
3. I will not engage in behavior that results in complaints from citizens or law enforcement in the community. This includes, but is not limited to, speeding, disturbing the peace, loitering, littering and use /possession of illegal substances.
4. I will only leave campus during the designated lunchtime 12:00-12:35.
5. I understand that my lunch privileges will be revoked for being tardy three times to 6th period.
6. I understand that these privileges may also be revoked for disciplinary concerns by parents and/or administrators.
7. I have read and understand the Utah State Law for vehicles and driving. Illegal and/or irresponsible driving will result in revocation of off campus lunch privileges as well as applicable demerits for misconduct.

I understand that going off campus at lunch is a privilege. My conduct in and out of school is a reflection of the respect I have for my school, others in the community, and myself. If my privileges are revoked I can earn them back at the beginning of the next term through responsible and appropriate behavior.
